Eligibility	Post Graduate Indian nationals from recognized State/Central Universities Institutions of National and International repute are eligible to apply with following eligibilities>  a) Master degree with minimum 60% marks in Economics/ Business Economics/ Agriculture Economics/ Public Administration/ Business Administration/ Chartered Accountant/ ICWA  b) At least 2 years post qualification experience relevant to the job description. The preference will be given to the persons with work experience in the relevant field supported by published work, policy papers/appraisal/ monitoring of projects & schemes etc
Age	Applicants should be below 42 years of age on the date of advertisement
